



### AMAZING PROVIDENTIAL CARE OF GOD

Recently we had quite an eventful trip to Korea. Ellen had an unexpected surgery in Korea on October 21. We were very surprised. But the timing was perfect and the heavenly Father orchestrated everything and provided wonderfully.

**Here’s what happened:** On our way to Korea on October 19 Ellen had an unusually heavy blood discharge over the Pacific in the airplane, even for a period. Then she got up on October 20 with still heavy bleeding, so we decided to go see a doctor. Our pastor friend here called his former disciple/student/staff at Sarang Church. Her father is an ob-gyn in Seoul. She happened to be in her father’s office when we called her. So we were able to get an appointment right after lunch. We got in and Dr. Jung did an ultrasound. His diagnosis was that Ellen had adenomyoma and one of the uterine fibroids had cut into the lining of the uterine cavity, causing the bleeding. So he scheduled a surgery (myolysis) for Ellen on October 21.

**Surgery and follow-up:** Ellen’s surgery lasted just under an hour, and Dr. Jung said that it went very well. She was given a regional anesthesia. Ellen stayed in the hospital for three days to do a complete checkup and follow-up. They gave her a private room to stay in and a floor mattress for me to sleep on. They provided excellent care. After checkout from the hospital on October 23, Ellen made daily visits to the hospital for follow-up examinations and treatments for eight days. Ellen recovered very nicely from the surgery.

**Here’s how the Father provided:** (1) Our pastor friend immediately canceled all our meetings on that week and moved them to the first week of November (which was empty because of an earlier cancellation). (2) Dr. Jung decided to cover all of the expenses and charges from the first examination on October 20 to the last follow-up visit on October 30. (3) Our friends in Korea were so amazingly loving and took excellent care of us, going out of their way to arrange food, lodging, and transportation. We are very grateful.

**Great cause for rejoicing:** We shared meals together with Dr. Jung twice, on November 2 and 5. And then we met with Dr. and Mrs. Jung on November 11 at their home and had wonderful conversations with them and their daughter, Youngah, until 1:30 at night. We had the greatest privilege of ushering them into the family of God through Jesus our Lord. Our hearts were filled with joy as Dr. and Mrs. Jung prayed to receive Christ into their life. They have been sensing the presence/intervention of God in their lives through recent events and together decided to start a new, exciting journey of faith in God who is their Creator and Savior. This is the fulfillment of Youngah’s deepest heart’s desire since she herself came to Christ eight years ago. God has answered her supplication and intercession for her parents.

**Pray:** Do pray that they together they will grow in their faith. Pray especially for Mrs. Jung as she has arrhythmia, an irregular pulse. Pray that she will grow deeper in her understanding of her newfound relationship with her heavenly Father through healing of this condition. Thank you for your prayers for God’s strength and grace for Ellen. She has recovered so amazingly well. Praise the Lord for his goodness and faithfulness!
