


PARTNERING TOGETHER SINCE 1952

In 2022, One Challenge turns 70 years old! The types of ministries, countries, and people have changed, but the foundation on which founder Dick Hillis created OC remains the same.

An essential building block of OC is partnership. In the 1950s, Dick Hillis, along with a few others, accepted an invitation from Madame Chiang Kai-shek to lead Bible studies for Taiwanese soldiers. Through this, God gave Dick the vision to partner with local believers to reach whole nations for the Lord. A critical component to reaching whole nations is partnering with other organizations, something OC has done since day one.

From these early beginnings, partnering with local communities of believers is at the heart of all OC ministries. It's not what individuals provide, but rather how all believers work together as one.
